## RULES & GUIDELINES

The Dairy Challenge Contest provides an opportunity for youth to increase their knowledge in many facets of the dairy industry as well as in agriculture as a whole. Each category will be either a written test, a hands-on model, or a combination. While the contest is in progress, there shall be no communication among the contestants or anyone else. There is no time limit to complete the challenge. Review of the questions will be held with all participants after the contest is completed and scored. This review session will maximize learning for the youth. In the event of a tie, the Superintendent will present 3 additional questions. Results and winners will be announced at the Awards Program held at the end of the Fair. There will be 2 sets of questions; Senior and Junior. Junior contestants must be 9 years old and less than 14 years old as of January 1 of the current year. Senior members must be at least 14 years old as of January 1 of the current year and not reached their 19th birthday prior to or on January 1 of the current year. No pre-registration is required.
