- 2. Flock: 1 ram (yearling or lamb), 2 yearling ewes, 2 ewe lambs
- 3. Breeder's Flock: 1 ram (yearling or lamb), 1 aged ewe, 1 yearling ewe, 1 ewe lamb
- 4. Pen of 3 lambs: both sexes must be represented.
- 5. Market Lamb: ewe or wether may not be shown in any other class.
- 6. Market animals should be slick sheared
- 7. Weight for market animals 85lbs minimum-150lbs maximum 8. Only purebreds are eligible for State Fair

- · Garments must be appropriate and attractive. Some part or all must be 100% wool and will be furnished by contestant
- · Sheep must be a registered ewe shown in the open or youth class and conditioned, fitted and trained to show at halter
- Sheep may not be decorated
- · Halter may be decorated with a ribbon or bow
- A summary sheet containing name, address, age, school attending or occupation, a brief biography (hobbies, other interest, etc.), breed of sheep being led and description of the contestant's outfit must be presented to the superintendent prior to show.

Scoring:	Points
Poise and appearance of contestant	30
Quality and appearance of garments	40
Control, presentation and appearance of ewe	30
Bonus if garment is hand made by contestant	15
