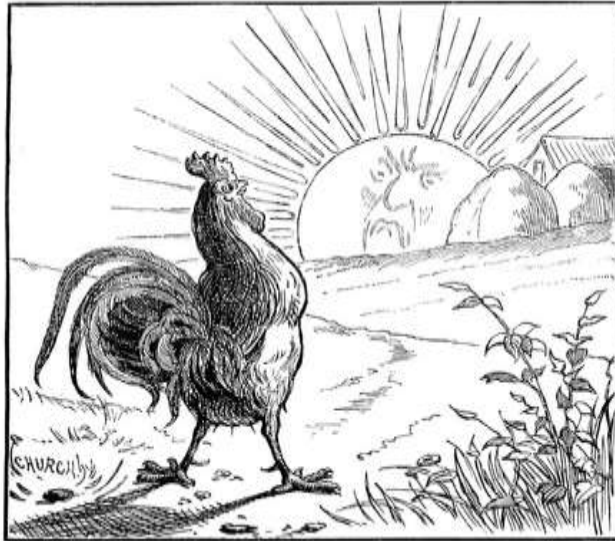

1. Blood test is required within 90 days prior to the fair.
2. The management assumes no responsibility in cases of loss or damage to stock other exhibits from any cause.
3. A valid pulorum certificate is required (except waterfowl) as well as any permits for game fowl.
4. Judging will be according to the APA and/or ABA Standard of Perfection.
5. The right is reserved to withhold the prizes awarded in every case in which it shall appear the management that the regulation has not complied with, or that fraud or deception has been attempted, or where the article or Animal is not worthy and its decision shall be final and binding on all parties.
6. Premium ribbons have NO value; premiums are paid only from the records of the judges.
7. Birds must be placed on coops as assigned by superintendent. Double cooping by same exhibitor may be necessary to conserve space.
8. Classes designated as AOV are for recognized breeds and varieties not previously listed unless otherwise indicated.
9. All poultry must be at least 6 months old.
10. There will be a \$5.00 fee to cover Chicken Feed.

**Section 20-Twilight Rooster Crowing Contest**  
**Wednesday August 9<sup>th</sup>-Saturday August 12<sup>th</sup>**  
**Premiums: \$20.00, \$10.00, \$5.00**

- Contest will be based solely on the number of “crows” recorded during specified periods and not the volume, tone or musical quality.
- The male having the most crows recorded to his credit at the end of the week will be declared Champion.
- Number of crows will be recorded during a 15 minute period each day.
- This contest has much practical value, as crowing indicated vim and vigor.
- Crowing contests have been a feature of Brussels, Belgium shows for many years, the theory being that the lustily crowing male is a worthy male for the thrifty, laying hen.
- All breeds and varieties of poultry entered in the regular classes are eligible.
- Exhibitor is to be present each night and is responsible for seeing their bird(s) are placed in competition and returned to their own coops.
