The Oswego County Fair will be held August 6th through the 11<sup>th</sup>. Please note: this a 6<sup>th</sup> Day Fair. Special Times for Special People will be on held this year. Set up is weekend prior to Fair or call for times.

Playland Amusements from Auburn, NY will be providing our rides.

The last day of the Fair will be a "Family Day". There will be no rides, but we are having free activities for fairgoers. We are planning games for all, throughout the fair grounds. On Sunday we still have animals on the grounds, including a huge Sanctioned Rabbit Show. We also have an Open Horse Show and a Sanction Goat and Cavy Show, The acts that we have hired for the week will also be on the grounds for at least two shows on Sunday. We are currently working on bringing some musical acts in for the day.

Vendor Fees remain the same, however a \$50 deposit is required for inside vendors and a \$100 deposit is required for outside vendors.

Camping is available with water and electric. Fees are \$35.00 per night for 20 amps per unit and \$50.00 for 50 amps unit per unit. Slide out units will be charged for two sites. If you need camping, you must complete the enclosed form. Your space will be reserved as long as you enclose a \$50.00 deposit. Charges start on the first night that you are parked. Please report to the main office prior to parking, and the camp ground superintendent will assist you in parking your camper
